SMART Goals is a good tool for helping us choose goals for CJSF/CSF

It is a great tool for helping achieve goals like our proposal for Science Night and Sports Day

This helps make sure goals for fundraising and other events are able to be successful



SPECIFIC

Be clear and specific so your goals are easier to achieve. This also helps you know how and where to get started!



MEASURABLE

Measurable goals can be tracked, allowing you to see your progress. They also tell you when a goal is complete.



ACTIONABLE

Are you able to take action to achieve the goal? Actionable goals ensure the steps to get there are within your control.



REALISTIC

Avoid overwhelm and unnecessary stress and frustration by making the goal realistic.



TIMEBOUND

A date helps us stay focused and motivated, inspiring us and providing something to work towards.

CJSF/CSF also wants to make PHS strengths even better. For example, improving the already great events held for students and sometimes the public.



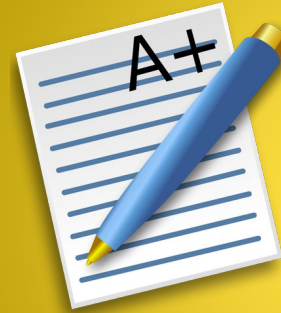
CJSF/CSF Peer Tutoring Program

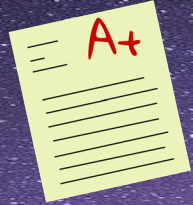

This is an actionable goal and will require CJSF/CSF students to sign up to tutor and help other kids so that they can learn and help others too.

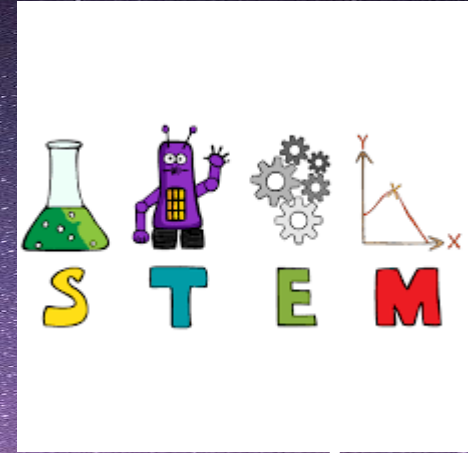
This goal is realistic because our CJSF/CSF students do well in school so they have spare time during tutorial and are bored and so they can have something to do and help others with their learning progress

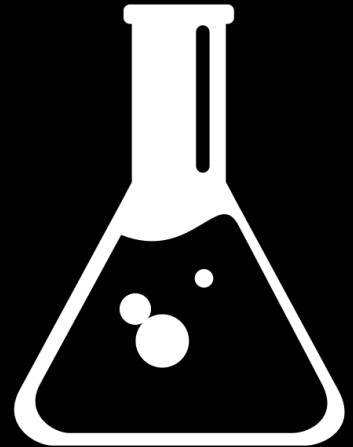

This event is an opportunity to outreach to the community, to engage parents and family, and a way to show people the culture of Portola Junior Senior High School.

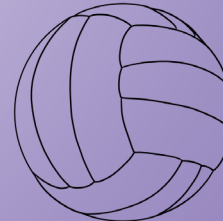
- Animal visitors

This goal is realistic because we have the power to carry it out; we have a local food bank partner; and 60% of our student body is free and reduced lunch	We will be trying this out for 1 semester before we assess and check in to make sure we are getting the outcomes we want.
