Submission Guidelines

- Sign your essay with your first name & word count. Please do not include your last name or school name in the essay.
- Typed & double-spaced.
- 600 – 800 words.
- Save your essay as a Word/doc file or PDF. (Only Word and PDF files will be accepted.)
- One entry per student.

Information you will need to provide when completing the application

- An email address where we can contact you; please use a non-school email or your parent's email.
- Your CJSF chapter number and region. Ask your adviser or look it up here
- Your CJSF Adviser's name and email address.
- Your school Principal's name and email address.
- Publicity Release form completed and signed by a parent or guardian.

Eligibility

- CJSF student members in 7th & 8th grades of chapters in good standing* are invited to submit an entry by the January 13th deadline.

*Chapter dues current through June 30, 2023.
